Improve mental health and criminal justice outcomes



To gauge the tangible outcomes of the Boost CYAC model, Deloitte performed an in-depth assessment of Boost CYAC's impact.

This 2017 study followed a mixed-methodology approach, using both significant change and social return on investment evaluations.

REDUCED EMOTIONAL, FINANCIAL AND PHYSICAL HARDSHIP ON CHILDREN WHO EXPERIENCE ABUSE AND THEIR FAMILIES:

- A trauma-informed approach to investigations enables coordinated teams of law enforcement, child protection, advocates, medical and mental health professionals
- Faster access to therapeutic services means reduced behavioural, emotional and psychological consequences
- Interventions at the family level, including caregivers, which result in better outcomes for children and youth



"In a non-CYAC case, clients may have to wait six to 10 months before they receive their first therapy session."

INCREASED ACCESS TO SERVICES FOR CHILDREN/YOUTH THAT HAVE BEEN ABUSED, AND FAMILIES:

- The Boost CYAC model increased the number, and timeliness, of individual referrals to community support services
- Faster consulting with medical and mental health professionals led to improved triaging of clients and accelerated the delivery of care to those with most urgent needs
- Boost CYAC advocates build longer relationships with children and families to offer additional support as needed



"If this case had not come through Boost CYAC, the CAS worker and police officer assigned to the case would have been primarily responsible for referrals. This process prolongs the time before the family actually receives services they need and puts the onus on the client to follow-up."

INCREASED CAPACITY OF PARTNER AGENCIES TO CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS:

- Medical and mental health professionals offer immediate consultation on the best treatments for children
- Teams quickly collect investigative information and share case details. These interactions between partner agencies create consistency and stronger working relationships, for better outcomes
- Team-members can share innovative, trauma-informed approaches and improve practice leadership and procedures
